



Edgewood Neighborhood Plan

About the Plan

The Organized Neighbors of Edgewood (ONE) is officially kicking off a neighborhood plan. The process will involve multiple opportunities for residents to participate. These efforts include focus groups, public meetings, a neighborhood survey, and ongoing discussions with an advisory committee and ONE.

The purpose of the planning effort is to update the 2009 neighborhood plan for Edgewood. This update will provide recommendations, strategies, concepts, and/or frameworks for improving the quality of life in the area. In 2024, ONE conducted a neighborhood survey to begin identifying guiding principles within the community and to inform the plan's vision and goals. These include:

Guiding Principle #1: Affordable living

Guiding Principle #2: Thoughtful development

Guiding Principle #3: Improved greenspace

Guiding Principle #4: Safety

Neighborhood volunteers are providing various skills and expertise to complete the plan. Atlanta's Department of City Planning is providing project management assistance. The plan is anticipated to be adopted in mid-2026 by the City of Atlanta and officially incorporated into *Plan A—Atlanta's 2025 Comprehensive Development Plan*, so it can guide decisions on Edgewood's future for years to come.
